393. TAYSIDE FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICE - PRESENTATION

The Committee heard a presentation by R Middlemiss, Group Manager, Tayside Fire and Rescue Service on their annual performance report (<http://www.taysidefire.gov.uk/cmsimages/media/pdf/Publication%20Scheme%20Documents/TAST%20Public%20Performance%20Report%202011-2012.pdf>). He reported on the progress made to date in reducing fire casualties by increasing fire safety visits to both residential and commercial properties. The 'Towards A Safer Tayside' consultation document would be published in November 2012 and, as part of becoming part of a single fire service in Scotland, a Local Plan would be developed.

Councillor D Pover requested that the Community Safety Committee's congratulations be conveyed to the Acting Chief Fire Officer for Tayside, Alasdair Hay, who had been appointed Chief Officer for Scottish Fire and Rescue Service.

394. REGULATORY SERVICES IN THE ENVIRONMENT SERVICE
