613. MINUTE OF PREVIOUS MEETING

614. APPLICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

There was submitted a report by the Director (Environment) (15/429), on applications received for financial assistance.

616. SOUTH INCH PAVILION, PERTH - PROPOSED FIT OUT WORKS
