2017/18 FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Joint Report by Head of Finance & Director (Environment)

PURPOSE OF REPORT

This report provides an update on 2016/17 Income and Expenditure, and details of the Income and Expenditure to 23 May 2017 and the projected outturn to 31 March 2018 for the Perth Common Good Fund.

1. BACKGROUND / MAIN ISSUES

1.1 The Committee approved the Perth Common Good Fund budget at the meeting of 22 February 2017 (Report 17/78 refers). This report provides an update on the final outturn for 2016/17, subject to audit, and the monitoring position and projected outturn for the Financial Year 2017/18.

2. PROPOSALS

2.1 Financial Statement 2016/17

Report 17/164 considered by Committee on 26 April 2017 included year-end projections for Income and Expenditure to 31 March 2017. Following closure of the 2016/17 accounts, which remain subject to audit by KPMG, the projected surplus has increased by £15,843 resulting in a surplus for the year of £51,066.

- 2.2 The movement from the previously reported surplus is mainly due to final adjustments for:-
 - £1,372 additional underspend on Property related expenditure
 - £5,993 unclaimed and withdrawn financial assistance applications
 - £3,348 underspend on Christmas Events costs
 - £3,859 increase in rental income during the year
 - £1,189 increase on interest on investments
- 2.3 Appendix 1 provides detail of the Income and Expenditure for year ended 31 March 2017 for the Fund. Also included within Appendix 1 are the total variances from the Approved Budget, all of which have been explained in Financial Statement reports to the Committee during the 2016/17 Financial Year. The total Revenue Account Balance at 31 March 2017 is projected at £1,645,726.

2.4 Financial Statement 2017/18

On the basis of Appendix 2, which includes the updated Revenue Account Balance noted in Section 2.3, it is anticipated that there will be surplus of £2,860 in 2017/18 and that the total Revenue Account Balance of the Fund will be £1,648,586 at 31 March 2017.

2.5 Of the total Revenue Account Balance, a minimum balance of £1,000,000 is set aside to ensure the longer term sustainability of the Fund, and £300,000 remains in an earmarked Repair and Renewal Reserve for Common Good property upgrade projects. The projected uncommitted balance available for the funding of additional discretionary expenditure is therefore £348,586.

3. CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION
