3. PERTH AND KINROSS ADULT PROTECTION COMMITTEE – BEINNIAL REPORT 2012-2014

There was submitted a report by the Depute Director, Housing and Community Care (G/14/275) seeking the Community Safety and Environment Group's support and approval for the Adult Support and Protection Biennial report prior to submission to the Scottish Government by 30 October 2014.
