4. REPORT TO BOARD ON ROYAL NATIONAL MOD 2022

The Board considered the Report on the options for extending licensed hours for the sale and consumption of alcohol for the MOD and MOD Feis, and determined as follows:

Agree that the MOD with MOD Feis is a special event of local and national significance such that during the period of Friday 14 October 2022 to Saturday 22 October 2022 social demand licensed hours are extended to 2am provided MOD Fringe or Feis related entertainment is taking place in the particular licensed premise. This applies only to those licensed premises within Perth City Centre, namely those premises within and immediately adjacent to the four ring roads of Caledonian Road, Atholl Street, Tay Street, and Marshall Place.

For the avoidance of doubt, reference to Friday 14 October to Saturday 22 October 2022 until 2am refers to the early hours of the following days, i.e. into Saturday 15 October at 2am until into Sunday 23 October 2022 at 2am.

Any premises wishing to operate these extended hours will require to have a trained first aider on the premises from 1am until close, each night.
