2. Remuneration and relevant allowances were subject to Income Tax and National Insurance.
3. Travel and subsistence expenses, where claimed, relate only to the reimbursement of actual expenditure incurred by the Councillor.
4. Reimbursement of expenses for overseas trips is included in the travel and subsistence columns. There were no overseas trips in 2022/23.
5. Costs met directly by the Council for the use of council officer driven cars have been noted for financial year 2022/23. A mileage rate of £0.15705 has been identified relating to costs associated with the provision of the vehicle. Staff costs associated with driving the vehicle have been estimated at an average of £20.55 per hour in addition to mileage costs.
6. Telephone and ICT Expenses - Support costs are met by the Council. There is no refund of any costs to elected members.
7. Civic Allowance - The Provost of the Council can incur expenditure up to a maximum of £3,000 to support his/her activities. £165.00 was claimed in 2022/23. This is in relation to clothing expenditure in order to attend engagements and host civic receptions.
8. The total value quoted per elected member includes direct costs met by the Council. These costs have not been claimed by the elected member.
9. The format of this report follows that prescribed in the Scottish Government's publication titled 'Councillors' Remuneration: Remuneration, Allowances and Expenses - Guidance (Revised April 2010)' to ensure consistency of interpretation between all Scottish Local Authorities.
