3. Remuneration and relevant allowances were subject to Income Tax and National Insurance.
4. Travel and subsistence expenses, where claimed, relate only to the reimbursement of actual expenditure incurred by the Councillor. All claims were receipted during 2020/21.
5. Reimbursement of expenses for overseas trips is included in the travel and subsistence columns. There were no overseas trips in 2020/21.
6. Telephone and ICT Expenses - Support costs are met by the Council. There is no refund of any costs to elected members. The variation of support costs to each elected member reflects the cost of supporting homeworking and annual rental costs for mobile telephones. The balance relates to costs incurred from telephone calls made as part of Council activities.
7. Civic Allowance - The Provost of the Council can incur expenditure up to a maximum of £3,000 to support his/her activities. None of this allowance was claimed in 2020/21.
8. Due to the current pandemic, the Council's official car was used to provide a courier service for Council Committee meetings and other duties to help out with other essential deliveries. The vehicle was not used by the Provost or any other Councillors for civic/ceremonial duties. Therefore, there are no costs to be apportioned to Councillors in the year 2020/21.
