- •28 IJB's reporting under spend between £1m and £55m;
- •Significantly driven by Quarter 4 SG Allocations to fund SG Priorities and Covid Spend in future years;
- Operational under spends driven by :-
 - Slippage in investment in new models
 - Temporary reduction in service provision
 - Increased recruitment timescales
- •Reserves have increased from £139m to £556m but VAST MAJORITY fully earmarked;
- •Despite reserves, recurring financial sustainability now a significant risk with refreshed plans required across all HSCP's
