PROPOSED TWINNING VISIT TO PERTH, ONTARIO – JULY 2016

PURPOSE OF REPORT

This report advises of an invitation extended to the Provost to visit Perth, Ontario from 24 to 26 July 2016 to celebrate Perth, Ontario's 200th anniversary.

1. BACKGROUND / MAIN ISSUES

- 1.1 Perth's twinning link with Perth, Ontario dates back to 2001. In 2016, the twinning link will be 15 years old.
- 1.2 Perth, Ontario was founded as a military settlement in 1816, and will celebrate its 200th anniversary in 2016.
- 1.3 John Fenik, Mayor of Perth, Ontario, has extended an invitation to the Provost to visit Perth, Ontario from 24 to 26 July 2016 to participate in their Homecoming Event, the biggest event of their 200th anniversary year-long celebrations.
- 1.4 Mayor John Fenik visited Perth in 2010 to participate in the Perth800 celebrations and again in 2012 to participate in the Diamond Jubilee Celebrations and the first Kilt Run held in Perth.
- 1.5 Provost John Hulbert visited Perth, Ontario in June 2011 and presented the prize to the winner of the second Kilt Run held in Perth, Ontario.

2. PROPOSALS

2.1 It is proposed to accept the invitation to visit Perth, Ontario from 24 to 26 July 2016, with the Council being represented by the Provost and the Chief Executive, supported by the Council Officer.

3. CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

3.1 Mayor Fenik has indicated that the year-long celebrations will be a tribute to their 200 years and will include many features that are part of their past. As many of Perth, Ontario's original settlers came from Scotland, he considers it very fitting that the Provost of Perth, Scotland, representing a strong connection to their history, is part of the celebration.

3.2 It is recommended that the Provost's Sub-Committee:

- i. agrees that the invitation to the Provost to visit Perth, Ontario from 24 to 26 July 2016 be accepted; and
- ii. agrees that the Council is represented by the Provost and the Chief Executive supported by the Council Officer.
